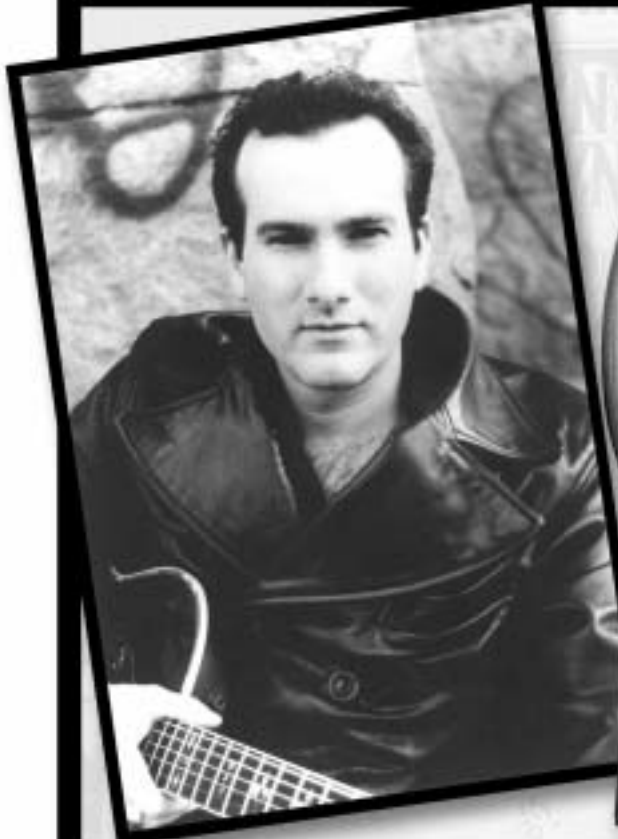

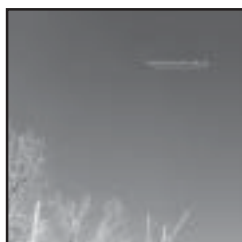

Mark Arm, Steve Turner and Dan Peters are from Mudhoney; Bill "Kahuna" Henderson is from Girl Trouble; Tom Price is from Gas Huffer; and Scott McCaughey founded the Young Fresh Fellows and the Minus 5, as well as being a (current, but non-original) member of R.E.M. Produced by Kurt Bloch (Fastbacks), The New Original Sonic Sound has 16 tracks from the Sonics songbook - "The Witch," "He's Waiting," "Strychnine," "Cinderella" and a whole lot more including THE Northwest national anthem, "Louie, Louie."  The Sons of Champlin were one of the Bay Area's best kept secrets in the late '60s. Revered by many but never quite managing to gain the national success they aspired to, the band was horn-driven amongst their guitar-soloing psychedelic brethren. Their name changed from the Sons of Champlin to the Sons and back again several times (with a short lived alternate name of Yogi Phlegm), until Bill Champlin went off to become the lead singer of Chicago in 1982. But you just can't keep a good band down. The core of the original band continued to make their music when their schedules allowed. Now with both a CD and a DVD, some 35 years on, the Sons of Champlin grace us with a live representation of their new millennium show which hearkens back to the Fillmore and Avalon Ballroom scenes of San Francisco in the late '60s. 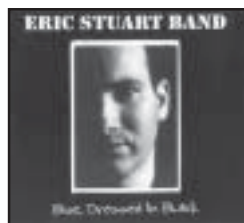

### Eric Stuart, "Blue, Dressed In Black"

 Eric Stuart has developed and honed his craft the old-fashioned way - by writing songs on an acoustic guitar and performing them live in front of audiences, totaling more than one million people. Eric is an artist who has spent his career nurturing his muse and creating a solid and steadily growing catalog of great songs, three of which were award winners of the coveted John Lennon Songwriting Award and two Billboard Songwriting Awards. In the summer of 1997, Stuart's classic rock 'n' roll style was noticed by Ringo Starr who invited him to open The Ringo Starr and His All-Starr Band Tour, featuring Peter Frampton, Jack Bruce (Cream), Gary Brooker (Procul Harum), and Simon Kirke (Bad Company). Originally, Stuart was only signed to do the first eight shows of the tour, but after his performance, Ringo asked him to play all twenty-eight shows. While on tour with Starr, Peter Frampton became a mentor for Stuart and a producer of his recording project, "Blue, Dressed In Black," along with John Regan and Harvey Jay Goldberg (Sting, Dave Matthews Band). Frampton also played guitar and sang background vocals on the project. Stuart is also the voice of over 25 Pokemon characters for both television and film projects.

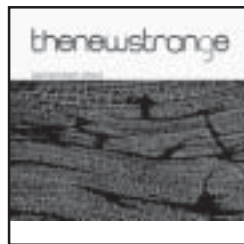

 "Hard to kill" - that would certainly summarize thenewstrange, if the summary was limited to just one sentence. "This band should have died a long time ago," a stranger once said - and it's no lie. The revolving door of cast members seems to have slowed down some, but in the past it's been a series of false starts and broken promises. It all sounds so melodramatic, but it's hard to get rolling when you have to find new members all the time. From jazz to punk, rock to electronic, blues to "brit-pop," you have to clear your mind and open your ears to get beyond the "influences" and hear a band spreading the sonic word via a dimly-lit, guitar-heavy, catchy sort of rock 'n' roll, specifically designed to carpet bomb all six of the senses.
